## WELCOME TO THE SOUTH COAST - PARADISE OF THE ZULU KINGDOM!

“Picturesque” is the most appropriate word to describe the KZN South Coast.

Endowed with lush forests, pristine beaches, and incredibly diverse flora and fauna, it is one of the most beautiful destinations in the world.

It is remarkable for its many golden beaches (some with blue flag status), tidal pools, world-class golf courses, scenic trails, Oribi and Umtamvuna River Gorges and other countless incredible leisure experiences.

Stretching 120 kilometres from Scottburgh to Port Edward, the KZN South Coast is a collection of charming towns and villages which include Scottburgh, Pennington, Hibberdene,

Port Shepstone, Margate and Port Edward.

While coastal resorts and unspoiled beaches are the main drawcard for the KZN South Coast, the magnificent hinterland encompassing the famous Oribi Gorge, historic KwaXolo Caves, rural villages, nature reserves and wilderness areas are also a major attraction.

One of the KZN South Coast’s best-kept secrets is the internationally-protected heritage site, the Red Desert. It is the smallest desert in the world at only 200m in diameter, resembling a miniature version of the Arizona Desert in the US. The desert consists of red soil

with archaeological artefacts dating back millions of years.

A visit to the KZN South Coast in winter will expose you to a fascinating marine spectacle, the sardine run. Known as the greatest shoal on earth, the event is likened to the East African wildebeest migration. It is the annual mass migration of billions of sardines from the temperate west coast that are pursued by a large number of predators such as game fish, sharks, whales, and dolphins. It also attracts birds such as Cape gannets, cormorants, terns and gulls.

## ENCHANTING CULTURAL HERITAGE

KZN South Coast Tourism prioritises responsible development of rural areas and has recently launched a few tourism initiatives which include the Umzumbe River Trail and the KwaNzimakwe Multi-Trails, which provide hikers, trail-runners and 4x4 enthusiasts with the opportunity to explore the Mpenjati River Valley. The KwaXolo Caves Adventure is a 300-metre cableway that takes visitors on a guided walk along a mountain path, with spectacular views into the KwaXolo Caves.

The KZN South Coast is made up of diverse cultures, with Zulu being the dominant one, particularly in the hinterland where a traditional way of life still exists. Other nations and cultures that have shaped the KZN South Coast are the Xhosas, Afrikaners, Indians and British. Explorers from different parts of the world, who settled and established small communities that still follow their traditions and speak their own languages have also influenced the local culture. Today the most common language spoken in KZN South Coast is isiZulu, with other dominant local languages being English, Afrikaans, and isiXhosa.

The best way to learn about a destination's culture is to spend time with the locals. A visit to Nyandezulu and KwaNzimakwe villages is a must. Here you will experience first-hand hospitality and a truly authentic and fulfilling encounter. Your experience will be incomplete if you do not try a traditional meal of chicken, Zulu steamed bread and spicy beans or spinach. Create your own unique screen-print at the Wowzulu Market or learn the skill of wrapping a doek /headscarf on your head.

Ntelezi Msani is another significant site worth visiting. it is a community-driven initiative, dedicated to preserving the local history, cultural, and creative activities of the KZN South Coast. Visitors will be taken on an informative journey, uncovering the origins and traditions of the Zulu Kingdom. Here you will also learn about the Zulu Nation's health and physical strength.

The Centre has a wide range of beautiful arts on display, and offers visitors an opportunity to take part in ancient stone throwing ritual or stick fighting.

This unassuming destination has produced some of the area's best and most successful artists.

## TRAVEL BACK IN TIME

A visit to kwaXolo Caves will expose you to San inspired art dating back some 100 000 years. These caves were once open-rock shelters for indigenous San communities. The caves house the ancient San Rock art that depicts the area's rich cultural heritage. The sites are believed to have had particular natural, cultural and spiritual significance to the San people.

The paintings are said to represent journeys of shamans (medicine men) into the spiritual world in an effort to induce rain, heal sicknesses and ease societal tensions. Learn about the KZN South Coast's fascinating history, which includes many shipwrecks, the Port Shepstone light house, Isivivane (a traveller's cairn created by King Shaka) and the tragic story of the São João – the great Portuguese galleon. There are also archaeological artefacts scattered throughout the Red Desert.





# KNZ SOUTH COAST MAP

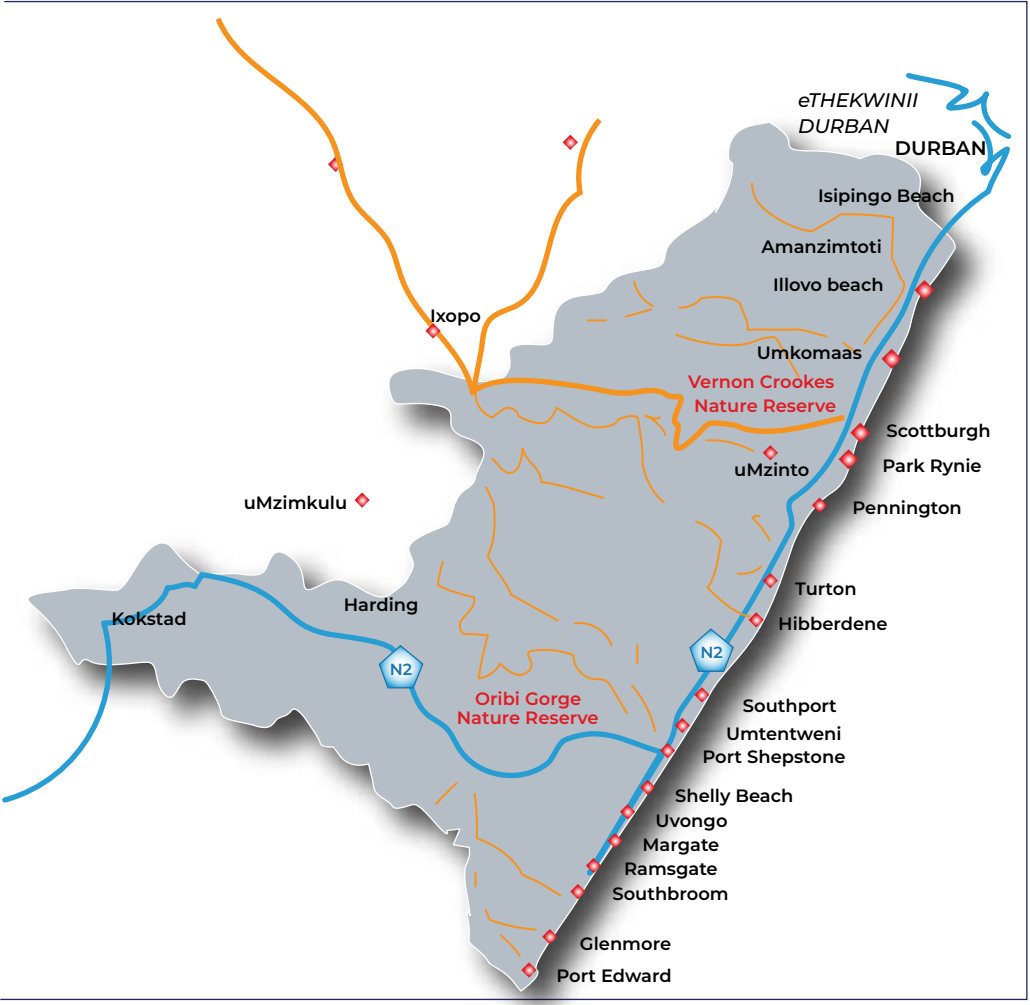
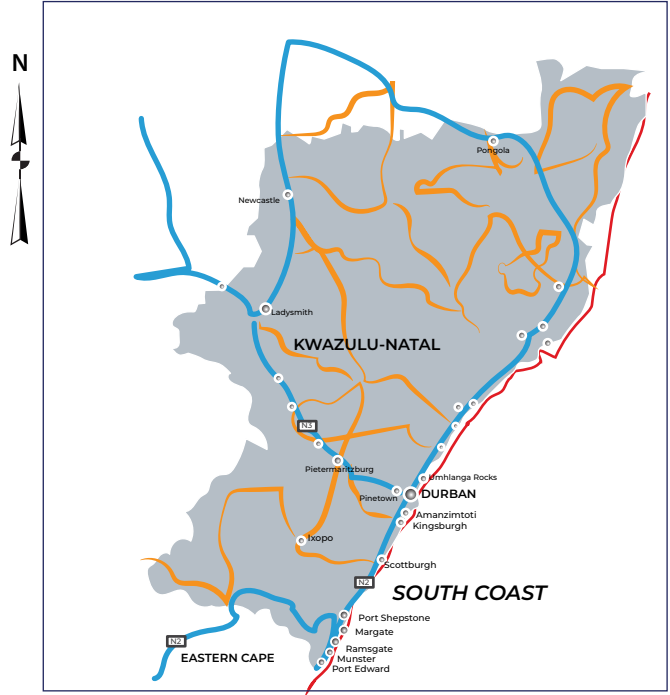
SOUTH AFRICA MAP

## ACCESSIBILITY

### Air

For domestic and international flights, the KZN South Coast is serviced by King Shaka International Airport, which is approximately 92km away, and Margate Airport, an alternative to those wanting to fly directly to South Coast. There is only one scheduled domestic flight between Margate and OR Tambo International Airport.

### Road

KZN South Coast is 45 minutes' drive from Durban and is linked to other major South African cities through the N2, N3, R61 and R102.

### Shuttle Service

Shuttle services from King Shaka International Airport (KSIA) service Durban station and all the major towns along the KZN South Coast. Some hotels offer their own shuttle services between their hotels and both airports.

### Public Transport

There are scheduled long distance buses that stop in the KZN South Coast.

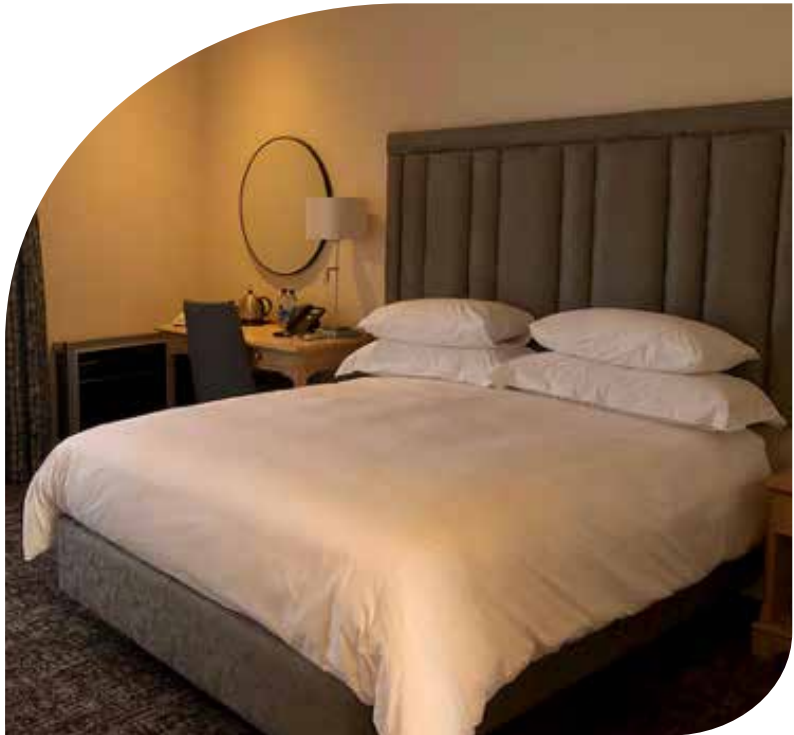

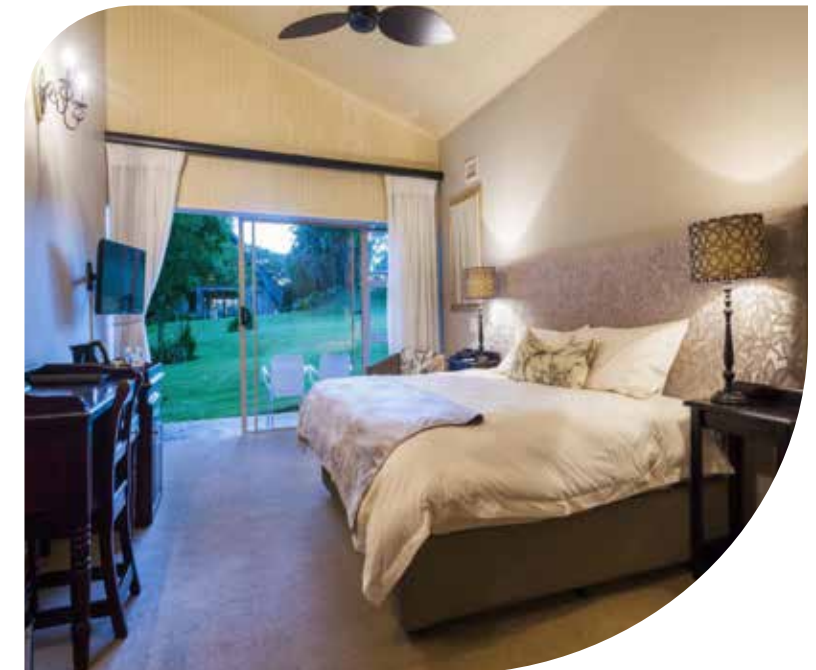

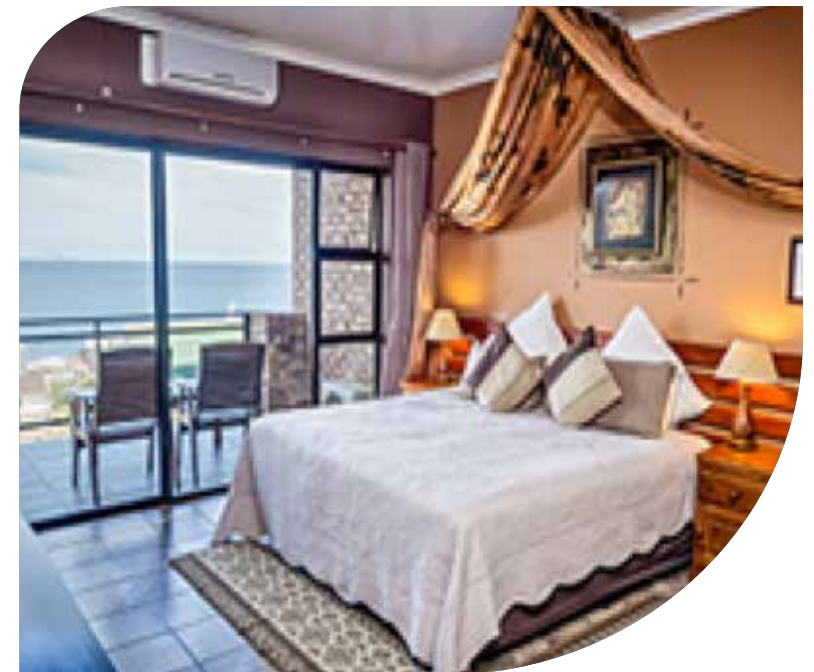

## USEFUL INFORMATION

### Currency

The rand (Code ZAR) is the currency of South Africa.

It has a symbol “R” and is subdivided into 100 cents.

### Taxes

VAT is currently at 15% and is included in the retail price displayed on most goods and services.

Visitors to South Africa may claim refunds on VAT paid on goods to be taken out of the country.

VAT refunds administration offices are found at all major international departure points.

To claim VAT, the original VAT invoice document is required.

### Time

South Africa's time is two hours ahead of Greenwich Mean Time (GMT). It is therefore an hour ahead of central European Winter Time, seven hours ahead of Eastern Standard Winter Time and seven hours behind Australian Central Time.

### Smoking

Smoking in public areas is prohibited, and is only allowed in designated areas. Most restaurants, hotels and other facilities have designated smoking areas/rooms

### Driving

KZN South Coast has good road infrastructure with beautiful scenery that makes road trips pleasurable.

### Car Hire

There are many car rental brands to choose from at all major airports and cities. Cars can be picked up and dropped off at different locations. It is mandatory that all car rentals rates include fire and third party liability insurance. All major credit cards are accepted as a payment method.

### Driver's licence

Any valid driver's licence is accepted in South Africa, provided it bears the photograph and signature of the holder and is printed in English. Drivers must carry a valid driver's license at all times of driving.

### Keep Left

South Africa drives on the left hand side of the road, and vehicles are passed on the right.

### Speed limit

The general speed limit on South Africa's national highways, urban freeways and other major routes is 120km/h. On secondary roads it is 100km/hour. In residential areas it is usually 60km/h and 80km/h unless otherwise indicated. Speeding is strictly enforced with cameras, and fines are high.

### Seatbelt

Wearing of seatbelt is compulsory. Using handheld phones while driving is against the law.
